The Rock of Christ - Assignment

"And now, my sons,...remember that it is upon the rock of our Redeemer, who is Christ, the Son of God, that ye must build your foundation; that when the devil shall send forth his mighty winds...when all his hail and his mighty storm shall beat upon you, it shall have no power over you to drag you down to the gulf of misery and endless wo, because of the rock upon which ye are built, which is a sure foundation, a foundation whereon if men build they cannot fall." (Helaman 5:12)

Matthew 5:

- [43] Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy.
- [44] But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;
- [46] For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?
- [47] And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so?

Luke 6:

- [31] And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.
- [32] For if ye love them which love you, what thank have ye? for sinners also love those that love them.
- [33] And if ye do good to them which do good to you, what thank have ye? for sinners also do even the same.
- [34] And if ye lend to them of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again.
- [35] But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil.

3 Nephi 11:

- [21] And the Lord said unto him: I give unto you power that ye shall baptize this people when I am again ascended into heaven.
- [22] And again the Lord called others, and said unto them likewise; and he gave unto them power to baptize. And he said unto them: On this wise shall ye baptize; and there shall be no disputations among you.
- [23] Verily I say unto you, that whose repenteth of his sins through your words and desireth to be baptized in my name, on this wise shall ye baptize them -- Behold, ye shall go down and stand in the water, and in my name shall ye baptize them.
- [24] And now behold, these are the words which ye shall say, calling them by name, saying:
- [25] Having authority given me of Jesus Christ, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.
- [26] And then shall ye immerse them in the water, and come forth again out of the water.
- [27] And after this manner shall ye baptize in my name; for behold, verily I say unto you, that the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Ghost are one; and I am in the Father, and the Father in me, and the Father and I are one.
- [28] And according as I have commanded you thus shall ye baptize. And there shall be no disputations among you, as there have hitherto been; neither shall there be disputations among you concerning the points of my doctrine, as there have hitherto been.

Meetings Conducted after the manner of the working of the Spirit and by the Power of the Holy Ghost

Moroni 6:

[9]And their meetings were conducted by the church after the manner of the workings of the Spirit, and by the power of the Holy Ghost; for as the power of the Holy Ghost led them whether to preach, or to exhort, or to pray, or to supplicate, or to sing, even so it was done.

John 14:

[13]And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. [14]If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do *it*

[16]And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; [17]*Even* the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

[18]I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

[26] But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Christ's Instructions on Washing Feet

John 13:

- [4] He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.
- [5] After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded.
- [6] Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?
- [7] Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter.
- [8] Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.
- [9] Simon Peter saith unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head.
- [10] Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.
- [11] For he knew who should betray him; therefore said he, Ye are not all clean.
- [12] So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you?
- [13] Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.
- [14] If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.
- [15] For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.
- [16] Verily, verily, I say unto you. The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him.
- [17] If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.

Mark 16:

- [15] And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- [16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

John 3:

- [16] For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- [17] For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

3 Nephi 11:

- [32] And this is my doctrine, and it is the doctrine which the Father hath given unto me; and I bear record of the Father, and the Father beareth record of me, and the Holy Ghost beareth record of the Father and me; and I bear record that the Father commandeth all men, everywhere, to repent and believe in me.

- [39] Verily, verily, I say unto you, that this is my doctrine, and whoso buildeth upon this buildeth upon my rock, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against them.
- [40] And whoso shall declare more or less than this, and establish it for my doctrine, the same cometh of evil, and is not built upon my rock; but he buildeth upon a sandy foundation, and the gates of hell stand open to receive such when the floods come and the winds beat upon them.
- [41] Therefore, go forth unto this people, and declare the words which I have spoken, unto the ends of the earth.

Matthew 5:

- [9] Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.
- [22] But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.
- [23] Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee;
- [24] Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.
- [25] Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison.

3 Nephi 11:

[30] Behold, this is not my doctrine, to stir up the hearts of men with anger, one against another; but this is my doctrine, that such things should be done away.

3 Nephi 12:

- [22] But I say unto you, that whosoever is angry with his brother shall be in danger of his judgment. And whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council; and whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.
- [23] Therefore, if ye shall come unto me, or shall desire to come unto me, and rememberest that thy brother hast aught against thee [24] Go thy way unto thy brother, and first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come unto me with full purpose of heart, and I will receive you.
