<p>Ether 1:33-43; 2: 1-3, 5-6, 16-18 Cried to the Lord -<u>Language not confounded, prepared for journey, led by pillar of cloud</u></p>	<p>Ether 2: 13-15 Failed to call on the Lord for 4 years, complacency – <u>chastised for 3 hours</u></p>
<p>Ether 2:15 Repented and called on the Lord – <u>forgiven and given another chance</u></p>	
<p>Ether 2: 18-22,3:4 Obedience: built barges, asked for light and air –<u>Gave light, provided for air</u></p>	
<p>Ether 3:6, 13, 16, 19,22,25 Obedience, faith, belief, diligence - <u>Brother of Jared saw the Lord's finger, was redeemed from the fall, saw Jesus Christ, commanded to write, and given two stones for interpreting, saw vision from beginning of time to the end</u></p>	
<p>Ether 6:9-12 Praised the Lord night and day – <u>safe arrival in Promised land</u></p>	
<p>Ether 6:27-30 Humble King Orihah taught people the Lord's ways – <u>Prosperity in land</u></p>	<p>Ether 7:4-5 Corihor rebelled against his father, Kib- led to <u>captivity</u></p>
<p>Ether 7:23-27 Shule protected prophets, word of God preached - <u>People repented, peace and prosperity restored</u></p>	<p>Ether 8:2-5 Jared rebelled against his father Omer - <u>Captivity of Omer – brothers battled against brothers</u></p>
	<p>Ether 8:9-12; 9:4-5 Jared sought Omer's death, Jared's daughter enticed Akish for the head of Omer, Akish agreed - <u>murdered Jared</u> instead</p>
<p>Ether 9:2-3 Omer served God – <u>fled to safety, his life was spared</u></p>	<p>Ether 9:6-8 Akish revived secret society - led to <u>corruption of all</u></p>
	<p>Ether 9:11 Akish's sons gained loyalty of people through bribery - <u>war between Akish and his sons</u></p>
	<p>Ether 9:12 Years of war - <u>mass destruction of people, few survived</u></p>
<p>Ether 9:13-14 Omer faithful to the Lord - <u>restored to power, anointed Emer to rule over people,</u></p>	
<p>Ether 9:15-20,22 Emer served God - <u>Curse removed, prosperity restored, saw the Lord</u></p>	<p>Ether 9:28 People rejected prophets - <u>great famine and poisonous serpents</u></p>
<p>Ether 9:35 People humbled- <u>Rain sent in time of dearth</u></p>	
<p>Ether 10:17-28 Corom, Kish and Lib served God - <u>Poisonous serpents destroyed – prosperity restored,</u></p>	<p>Ether 11:5-7 Prophets killed – <u>great calamity: wars, famines, pestilences, great destruction</u></p>
