



Lesson: King Benjamin's Heritage (Mosiah 1-5)

King Benjamin's Heirlooms: *Objects/lessons King Benjamin inherited and passed on to his son's & his people*

Heirlooms	Value/Significance	
	<i>Plates of brass (Mos. 1:3-4)</i>	<i>Preserved God's word, reinforced beliefs</i>
	<i>Egyptian language (Mos. 1:2;4)</i>	<i>Ability to read God's word</i>
	<i>Plates of Nephí (Mos. 1:6-7)</i>	<i>History of family and God's prophecies</i>
	<i>Kingship given to Mosiah (Mos. 1:10)</i>	<i>Continuation of legacy and righteous leadership</i>
	<i>Sword of Laban (Mormon v.13)</i>	<i>Remembrance, used to fight battles</i>
	<i>Liahona (Mos. 1:16-17)</i>	<i>Teaches that believing in Christ is the only way to receive salvation (Mos. 3:17)</i>
	<i>A special name given to his people (Mos. 1:11)</i>	<i>Spiritual identity and heritage</i>
	<i>How to be a servant to God and man (Mos. 2:17)</i>	<i>Teaches people to care for the needy; be generous</i>

Summary: *To instill the value of truth and knowledge of future events and prophecies; know of God's plan; how to receive salvation; preserving the gospel for future generations. Without the plates the knowledge of God would be lost.*

God's Heirlooms: *God's promises/gifts to us – Our spiritual inheritance*

	<i>Bible &amp; Book of Mormon</i>	<i>Knowledge of God and His plan</i>
	<i>Christian Music / Songs of Zion</i>	<i>Part of Praise and worship</i>
	<i>The Gospel of Christ</i>	<i>Imparts salvation, knowledge of God</i>
	<i>Gifts of the Spirit</i>	<i>Evidence of God with us</i>
	<i>Plan of salvation</i>	<i>Redemption, freedom from guilt</i>
	<i>Eternal life with God &amp; Christ</i>	<i>Ultimate joy and reward</i>
	<i>Physical healings &amp; protection</i>	<i>Provider and protection</i>

Summary: *Through our heirlooms we gain our identity as children of Christ and God. We develop a relationship with God the creator. We can have the Holy Spirit indwelling to lead and guide us.*
