### **GRADES 7-9**

### HOLY BIBLE

Isaiah 2:4, "And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more."

### THE BOOK OF MORMON

### **OBJECTIVES**

Participants will be able to:

 Describe God's plan for peace on earth, 2 Nephi 30:12-18, 3 Nephi 21:1,23-25, Isaiah 2:2-4, 65:17-25, Ether 13:6-8.

### **ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS**

- What is God's kingdom of peace called?
- How will people and animals behave in Zion? How can we apply those behaviors in our lives today?
- Who will build God's kingdom of peace? How can we help build this peace in our community?

### MATERIALS

Bibles and Books of Mormon White Board, marker Poster board/ large sheets of paper, markers, tape **Scriptural Texts:** 1 copy per student, pages 3-5. Highlighter markers - 1 per student. **Task 2**: Supply needed items. **Song:** *The Songs of Zion* #107, "They Say The Land Has Milk And Honey"

#### **TEACHER NOTES**

45-minute lesson. May be divided into multiples sessions.

To prepare for this lesson, study the scriptural references listed in **OBJECTIVES.**

### PROCEDURE

### Motivation/Introduction (3-5 minutes)

Engage students in a discussion to consider Zion-like conditions.

**Q:** Can you imagine having a dragon for a pet? A bear? Can you imagine petting either one?

**Q:** Can you imagine a neighborhood where you would not lock the doors?

**Q:** Can you imagine a world where no 'bad' words are spoken? No one argues or fights? No one is murdered?

A time of peace on earth among animals and people is described in God's Word.

**Q:** What is this period of time called? (Peaceful Reign/Zion)

Goal: Describe God's plan for peace on earth.

### Lesson Development (40 minutes)

- 1. Engage students in a scripture search to identify and describe conditions of the peaceful reign.
  - Hand each student the Scriptural Texts pages below, and highlighter markers. Students take turns reading scriptures aloud. Students identify and highlight text that depicts the peaceful reign/Zion.
  - In their own words, students describe/summarize conditions of the peaceful reign/Zion. Create a list of responses on poster board, and display for all to see.
  - c. Students compare/contrast to world conditions today.
- 2. Discuss Essential Questions.
- Assign students a task to demonstrate their understanding of the peaceful reign. Suggestions below:
  - a. Task1: Students will identify a problem in their community, brainstorm possible solutions, and create a plan to help resolve it in order to bring peace to others. Consider dividing students into small breakout groups of 2-3.

- b. Task 2: Students illustrate God's plan for peace on earth through song, art, literature...
- c. Option: Teacher thinks of a task.
- 4. Memory Verse: (Assign to memorize)
  - **2 Nephi 30:15**, "They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain; for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea."

# Description of the Peaceful Reign/Zion

Instructions: Highlight words/phrases that describe peaceful conditions.

### 2 Nephi 30:12-18.

[12] And then shall the wolf dwell with the lamb; and the leopard shall lie down with the kid, and the calf, and the young lion, and the fatling, together; and a little child shall lead them.
