## PROCEDURE

### Motivation/Introduction (3 minutes)

 Engage students in a discussion on the meaning of, "God bless you."(Numbers 6:24-26)

**Q:** Have you ever heard someone say, "God bless you?"

**Q:** Can you think of what "God bless you" means? (To ask God to protect and take care of someone).

# Goal: We will explore a time when Jesus showed great love for little children by blessing them.

### Lesson Development (20 - 25 minutes)

- Share a retelling of Jesus blessing little children (Use an illustrated story book, display a picture (Page 3), watch a video, and/or use "Story Map").
- Discuss the first two Essential Questions (Page 1).
- 3. Lead children in singing, "Jesus Loves Me."
- 4. Portray and relate how we follow Jesus's example in The Church of Jesus Christ:

**Q**: Who has seen a baby or small child blessed in our church?

- a. Hold two pictures side by side in front of students: Jesus blessing children (Page 3) and an minister blessing a child (Click <u>here</u>).
- b. In our church, parents bring their little children to the ministers (Men chosen to lead Jesus's Church) to be blessed, just like in Jesus's time. The minister holds the child in his arms and asks God, our Father in heaven, to always take care of and protect the child.
- 5. Discuss the remaining Essential Question (Page 1).
- 6. Give students a coloring sheet of blessing a child (Link page1) and crayon/markers.

### Story Map: Jesus Blesses Little Children

This true story of Jesus blessing children is found in the Bible. One day long ago, when God's Son, Jesus, lived on the earth, many mothers brought their children to Him, seeking a blessing. The mothers love their children and want Jesus to ask God to take care of them.

Jesus's disciples scold the mothers, saying "Jesus is busy. Don't bother Him." Jesus scolds His disciples for sending the children away. Jesus says, "Bring the children to me. I love little children. They are welcome in heaven." Jesus held the children in His arms, one by one, and prayed to His Father in heaven asking Him to bless them.
